



**Ordinance 15-09
Amendment of Running at Large
Ordinance to Include Town of
Ashland**

Ordinance No. 15-09

- Ordinance to amend Section 4-74 of the Hanover County Code—“Running at Large Prohibited; Penalty for Violation.”
- Currently, running at large prohibited year-round in suburban service area, areas zoned R-1, R-2, R-3, R-4, R-5 and R-6, in county parks and on the grounds of any schools operated by the county school board.

Ordinance No. 15-09

- June 24, 2015 – Hanover County Board of Supervisors approved an Agreement with the Town of Ashland providing for the enforcement of the County’s animal control laws in the Town of Ashland.
- The Town of Ashland has requested that the Hanover County Board of Supervisors extend the year-round prohibition of running at large to the Town of Ashland.

Ordinance No. 15-09

(b) It shall be unlawful for the owner of any canine or canine crossbreed to allow such canine or canine crossbreed to run at large, at any time, in the urban service area, as defined in the subdivision ordinances, or in the areas of the county zoned R-1, R-2, R-3, R-4, R-5 and R-6, in county parks, on the grounds of any schools operated by the county school board, or anywhere in the Town of Ashland.



Ordinance 15-09

Running at Large – roaming, running, or self-hunting off the property of its owner and not under its owner's immediate control. (Section 4-1 of Hanover County Code)
